These projects introduce basic computer skills, terminology, keyboarding, and mouse skills including the following:

Learning Objectives

- open and close a program**
- open, close, save and print a file**
- locate keys on the keyboard**
- understand the function of keyboard keys**
- gain fine motor skills to use the mouse**
- type, select, and format text**
- insert pictures and clip art**
- draw and format shapes**
- create slides and apply simple animations**
- view, add, and filter records in a database**

The students will be introduced to Microsoft Office applications by completing activities that are educational and easy to learn as follows:

- Microsoft Word**

- Microsoft PowerPoint**
- Microsoft Access**
- Microsoft Paint**
- Microsoft Publisher**
- Internet Explorer**

The technologies would be used to provide computerized lessons in math, science, grammar, writing, reading, and other courses as outlined in the course structure.

We will reach out to males and females in the grade ranges of Kg-Kg5 and JS1-JS3/preschool to 9th grade as outlined in Ghana school systems.

In the second phase of the project we hope to grow by 100 more male and female students in adult Technology Advancement curriculum.

According to the below website, Ghana did not have any expenditures in the area of Science and Technology for the period of 1982 to 1991. This set

back has declined their growth to present in this much needed area of Technology advancement.
